Artificial Intelligence in Public Sector Service Delivery: Opportunities, Challenges, Performance Excellence

Bangladesh Public Administration Training Centre (BPATC) organized a one-day Seminar on 'Artificial Intelligence in Public Sector Service Delivery: Opportunities, Challenges, Performance Excellence' at 02nd November, 2025. The Seminar was inaugurated by Rector to the centre Mr. Sayeed Mahbub Khan. A total number of 40 (forty) participants attended the seminar. Among them 26 (twenty-six) were male and 14 (forteen) were female participants.

Main objectives of this seminar was to experimentation with and sometimes funding for government AI to automate, to

processes, guide decision making and develop anticipatory services for citizens. Cross-government, cross-sector and international collaboration through, to councils, networks, communities and partnerships. Strategic management and use of government data, including open data, to fuel and to establishment of conditions and guidelines for transparent, ethical and trustworthy use of AI in government and to enhancement of civil service capacity through training, tools and recruitment.

Towards Sustainable Public Policy and Local Implementation
